## SUNDAY 26 March 2023 Fifth Sunday in Lent Year A

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

Another long Gospel Passage on this fifth Sunday of Lent follows the long ones we have read on the third and fourth Sundays. It is worth noting that there is a deliberate reason behind these three long, but different, gospel passages from St. John. They have been selected specifically for the instruction of those preparing for Baptism. Although we do not have candidates to be received into the Church at Easter this year, these three gospels are powerful depictions of the



hidden transformation God accomplishes in people who are going through the RCIA. They have been chosen to emphasize repentance and conversion as the Light of Christ comes to pierce the darkness of sin and to bring life where there is death.

There is an unbroken link between the healing of the blind man, which we heard last weekend, and the raising of Lazarus from the dead. Both stories, undoubtedly, were intended to manifest the glory of God. Jesus knew what He was doing when He got the news of Lazarus's sickness and decided to stay back two more days before making His way to Bethany. It appeared Jesus ignored an emergency desperate message from Martha and Mary. 'Lord the man you love is ill.' We can only think that Jesus acted deliberately. He loved Martha, Mary and Lazarus, and yet when He heard that Lazarus was ill, He stayed where He was for two more days before saying to His disciples, 'Let us go to Judea.'

In the synoptics, there are instances where dead people were raised to life for example, the son of the widow of Nain (Luke 7:11-17) and the daughter of Jairus, the Synagogue official (Luke 8:41-42; 49-56). In these two instances, death had only occurred just as Jesus arrived at the scene. Neither of them had yet been buried. In other words, Lazarus is the only instance of someone being raised to life after being dead and buried. This certainly makes the story of Lazarus the last and greatest miracle performed by Jesus Christ. However, it also exposed Jesus to greater danger - He could no longer walk openly because the Jews were after Him.

As we approach the end of the Lenten season and enter Holy week, we are invited to contemplate the real God whom Jesus Christ has revealed to us. The real God who took flesh and lived like us in all things but sin and who died for our sake on the cross, hates pain, suffering, and death. God weeps when we weep. God is broken when we are broken. One of the hardest things in life is to see the person you love suffer. God loves us unconditionally and struggles in our pain and suffering. We sometimes struggle with questions about how a God who is all good, all-powerful, and all knowing could allow evil in the world or allow bad things to happen to good people. At any point in our journey of life, when, for whatever reason, we doubt or question the goodness of God, let us remember that the real God weeps and cries when we are in pain. It was obvious that Jesus loved Martha and Mary so much that He could not bear the sight of their tears and emotional pain. The heart of Jesus Christ was broken at the sight of such human pain and grief. Christ was deeply moved to the depth of His being. He came to reveal a God whose heart is also wrung with anguish and pain, when we are in pain. As Christians, we have a responsibility not only to reveal this real God to other people through what we say, but more importantly through our concrete acts of love and kindness.

In these last days of Lent, let us contemplate, and make sense of the real God who cares for us, through the love and care we show to other people.


## VERSE FOR VINNIES - Gary Fogarty


