SUNDAY 4th June 2023 The Most Holy Trinity Year A

This weekend we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast forms the foundation of our faith as Christians. In fact, it sums up God's revelation which was brought about through the Paschal Mysteries: Christ's death and resurrection, Christ's ascension to the right hand of the Father and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Christianity appears to be the only religion, whose God is a family. God reveals Godself as a communion of persons - one God in three persons. God is not a solitude but a communion, in which the ocean of God's being vibrates with an infinite movement of love, reciprocity, exchange, encounter, family and celebration.

Nowhere in the whole Christian Bible is the word, 'Trinity', explicitly mentioned. However, the entire Bible is replete with the idea or understanding of God as a communion of persons. With amazement we contemplate the mystery of the Trinity when "at the beginning of creation" God says, 'let us make the human persons in our image and likeness'. The image God speaks about before the creation of the human beings is not that of the exclusive image of the Creator, nor of the Spirit, nor of the eternal Word of God, but it is of all the three persons in the Godhead.

In the second reading of this weekend, Saint Paul concludes his letter to the Corinthians thus: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all." This is a very familiar passage for us. It is often used as the greeting at the beginning of Mass. While this is a greeting *cum* prayer, it is also a profession of faith in the God who reveals Himself as 'Father, Son and Holy Spirit.'

Our entire celebration of the mass is focussed on the Trinitarian mystery. When we were baptised, we were baptised "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit". Every time we cross ourselves with the sign of the Cross, we remember God's name in which we were baptized. Remarking on the profound significance of the sign of the Cross, a one-time German Catholic priest, philosopher and theologian, Romano Guardini, wrote: "we do it before praying so that... we may put ourselves spiritually in order; focus thoughts, heart and will on God; after praying, so that what God has given us may remain within us.... It embraces the whole being, body and soul... and everything is consecrated in the name of the Triune God".

The doctrine of the Trinity has remained for us a mystery which puzzles and doesn't always seem to capture our imagination. This is why we can easily be drawn into the impression that the doctrine is nothing more than a truth to be believed but with little or no existential implications in our daily life. The doctrine of the Trinity, when

May the grace, which flows from our celebration of the feast of the Most Blessed Trinity, bring love and unity into the life of every Christian, our families, our Church and our world.

Health and Safety - 02-06-2023

Although the Parish appreciates that dogs and pets are an important part of life for many of OLA's families and volunteers, however, it also acknowledges that bringing dogs into a child-focused environment and around elderly, unsteady people, carries with it the risk of physical injury to children and adults, no matter how friendly or well-controlled those dogs may be. Having dogs on Parish property may create anxiety for those children or adults who may find contact with dogs frightening.

Those involved in the care and use of animals should be aware of the potential disease hazards and other associated occupational health and safety issues and manage risks according to the Parish's risk management process. Apart from injuries which may occur due to trip hazards and falls caused by dogs being underfoot, unruly, animated, and lively, there are a variety of infectious diseases (Zoonotic diseases) that are transmissible from various animals to humans. There is also the issue of appropriate dog and animal hygiene.

Service dogs (seeing-eye, hearing assistance, etc) are allowed on Parish property with their owners.

Blue Card News - May 2023 Issue

Blue Card Obligations

Just like blue card holders and applicants have obligations they must comply with under the Blue Card system, so too do employer organisations.

Obligations for regulated employer organisations (our employer organisation is The Archdiocese of Brisbane) include:

- not starting a person in any child-related work without a valid blue or exemption card,
- taking reasonable steps to confirm the card holder's identity,
- linking a card holder when they start as a volunteer in Our Lady of the Angels' Parish, Chermside,
- de-linking a card holder when they leave their volunteer role in OLA Parish,
- for the Archdiocese, through information and support from the Parishes, to maintain a register of people engaged in interacting with children,
- developing and implementing a child and youth risk management strategy, and
- letting Blue Card Services know when there is a change in the organisational protocols.

Failure to comply with the Blue Card laws can be an offence and could result in penalties for non-compliance – not only to the employer organisation, but also to the individual.
