Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

This weekend, the parables of the 'treasure hidden in a field, the pearl of a great value and the dragnet cast in the sea,' conclude the thirteenth chapter of the gospel of Matthew, which we have been reading and reflecting over the last three weekends.

The parables of the 'treasure hidden in a field and the pearl of a great value' can be classified as twin parables, which Jesus used to tell the story of the inestimable value and irresistible beauty of discovering and embracing the veracity of the existential reality of God.

In the ancient world, or in war torn countries and those frequently invaded by enemies, it was very common for people to store their precious possessions in the tombs, or in fields or caves as they fled from danger. When people buried their precious possessions in any of these places, they did so with the hope of coming back when it was safe to return and recover them. Unfortunately, it wasn't always the case. There was the inevitability of death; people were often killed - which also meant the death and disappearance of all knowledge of the hidden treasures. Therefore, while the first two parables may sound strange and even unusual due to the nature of modern banking systems, in Palestine during the time of Jesus, burying money and other valuable items in the ground was a common practice. People used the ground as the safest place to keep their most cherished items or belongings. We remember the parable of the servants where the man who got one talent decided to bury his talent in the ground lest he should lose it (Matt 25:25).

Thus, in the parables of the treasure hidden in the field and the pearl of a great value, Jesus teaches on the boundless treasure of the kingdom of God. It is not as though He was just trying to identify or associate the kingdom of God with worldly riches and possessions. There is nothing in this world that matches the riches of the kingdom of heaven which are immeasurable and far superior to the most precious values in the world.

Pope Francis in his apostolic exhortation- Evangelii Gaudium (the joy of the Gospel) said that: 'the joy of the gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus Christ. Those who accept Christ's offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness. With Christ, joy is constantly born anew'. There is simply an undying joy and fulfilment associated with knowing Jesus Christ personally and intimately. Quite often people who do not understand Christianity wonder why we would give up sleeping in on Sunday morning to come to Mass. There might even be Catholics who are too busy to come Mass because they don't understand why they should sacrifice Sunday family breakfast or family time it. Human life stands or falls on the truth and the indisputable place God occupies in the larger scheme of our lives.

As Christians we may be prepared, to pay no less a price than everything as we strive every day to re-discover the inestimable value of having faith in God and doing all we can to nurture and live out our faith in our beautiful but often broken world.

10 Year Anniversary


Next weekend we will be celebrating the 10 year anniversary of the Parish. We will have pre-dinner nibbles after 4.30pm Mass.


