# SUNDAY 6th August 2023 The TRANSFIGURATION of the Lord Year A

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. It is one of the feasts of the Lord - and it is one of the important ones. Its importance is obvious given the fact that when it falls on a Sunday, its liturgy is not combined with the Sunday liturgy, but completely replaces it. As one of the feasts of the Lord, the Feast of the Transfiguration underlines the fact that in Jesus Christ is salvation, joy and glory; and the fullness of God's revelation is pleased to dwell in Him. The mystery of the transfiguration is a pivotal moment in the life of Christ and His disciples. It appears as a foretaste of the Paschal Mystery, and it offers a moment of change which is both fundamental and supernatural.

The gospel pericope which has been offered for our reading and reflection this weekend opens with 'Christ took with Him Peter, James and John to a high mountain. On this mountain, Jesus was transfigured before them. The face of Jesus shone like the sun, and Jesus' clothes became as white as the light. Just then there appeared before them Moses and Elijah, talking with Jesus', (Matthew 17: 1-3). Peter, James and John would have been shocked and amazed at what they had experienced on the mountain. As they were watching, the poor Galilean, the Son of Mary and the Son of the carpenter was transfigured. The event wasn't reported to them. They saw it when it happened and they experienced it firsthand. They saw as Jesus was conversing with Moses who represented the law as well as Elijah who represented the prophets. Finally, there was also a voice which echoed from heaven and identified Jesus Christ as the beloved Son of God. The voice did not only reveal the identity of Christ; the voice also directed them to listen to Him.

They had no further reason to doubt the messianic mission of Christ. In Matthew 16: 21-22, "... Jesus began to explain to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to you!" (Matthew 16:21-22). This experience on the mountain must have banished from the minds of Peter and the other disciples any confusion and doubt they might have had on the identity and mission of Christ as the Suffering Messiah.

As 21st century disciples of Christ, the Feast of Transfiguration invites us to open the eyes of our hearts to the mystery of our faith and the transformation which can happen in us through our liturgies, especially the Mass. The three disciples who were on the mountain with Christ were never the same after their encounter with transfigured Christ. "Lord, it is good that we are here," Peter exclaimed. (Matthew 17: 4) 'In God's presence there is fullness of joy,' (Psalm 16:11). Peter, James and John had a sense of the glory of the resurrection, a glimpse of heaven on earth, a taste of paradise. This experience of joy should be our collective experience whenever we come to Mass, participate fully in the prayers and share in the gifts of Christ's Body and Blood. Joy is an infallible sign of Christ's presence amongst His people. In his apostolic exhortation, Evangeli Gaudium, the Joy of the Gospel, Pope Francis said: "the joy of the gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. Those who accept His offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness. With Christ joy is constantly born anew."

Like Peter, James and John, may our faith in the risen and glorified Lord always stir up in us the joy which comes from the gospel and from a deep and personal experience of Jesus Christ.

The youth group will be sending kids to the Ignite Conference coming up in September. This conference is a great opportunity for the young people in our community to experience faith and connect with other young Catholics.






