Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

Forgiveness is not always an easy thing to do. This is because we don't easily discard things which have hurt our feelings and wounded our spirit. - and the bigger the hurt or the injury the more difficult it is to forgive and let go. Until someone has personal things to forgive, it might not



be really understand what a hard process it is. In the gospel this weekend, it appeared Peter had some difficulty with this. It was obvious in Peter's question to Jesus, "Lord, how often must I forgive my brother or sister if he or she wrongs me? As often as seven times?" Perhaps, Peter got to a point where he felt sick of forgiving people, who continued to hurt him deeply. The common teaching at the time was that one must forgive an offender at least three times. Although the prescribed norm was three times, Peter appeared happy to go beyond the prescribed norm to a point where revenge would seem absolutely justifiable. In the Bible, the number seven often symbolizes perfection, completeness, and fullness. When Peter suggested seven, he thought Jesus would have commended him. He would have been startled that Jesus instead said: "I say to you, not seven times but seventyseven times." In other words, there is no limit to the number of times that we must be prepared to forgive. It was as if Jesus said to Peter, 'the number 'seven' might be the number of perfection and completion but it does not apply to the supernatural and enormous liberating power of the Holy Spirit which touches hearts to forgive and let go.

As Christians, the appeal to forgive and let go might be coming to some of us perhaps in the face of many injuries and hurts we have harboured for years. These wounds might be because of resentment we have continued to carry toward our parents, siblings, friends or neighbours. It is obviously true that people have done things to hurt others. How can a paedophile be forgiven for manipulative behaviour which denies children their innocence and undermines their chances for healthy intimacy? What about a murderer who has killed the joy of a family when one of their loved ones was brutally murdered? In the week of the anniversary of 9/11, would the world ever forgive the terrorists who blew up innocent people in New York and left many families permanently shattered? As a people and as individuals, we have been offended and we probably nurse anger. We have treasured this anger, maybe even to the extent of allowing it to become hatred. But what the anger or hatred we retain has done to us, is to hold us back from forgiving. Ironically, we have been imprisoned and oppressed. No one grows while held down or in bondage of any sort. Nelson Mandela understood the power of forgiveness, when he said: "as I walked out the door toward the gate that would lead to my freedom, I knew if I didn't leave my bitterness and hatred behind, I'd still be in prison." He made this comment after over two decades of being in jail because he stood for truth and justice. (Contd. P2)

(Continued from P1.) We can set ourselves free if we choose to forgive and let go. Forgiveness follows from a conscious decision to let go and move on. Forgiveness liberates and sets people free. It is not what we do for the people who have offended us but what we do for ourselves - so that we can be released to move forward. When we have been hurt and we choose not to forgive, we simply remain in the power and control of whoever has hurt and injured us. Whenever we have been hurt, in making the choice to forgive, we are not expected to blot out painful memories, rather we can act on them in creative and life-giving ways.

Let us pray for the grace, courage and strength to forgive and let go when we have been deeply hurt and wounded.


