Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

As creatures made in God's image and likeness, God always places an incredible amount of trust in us. In reflecting on this trust as well as the enviable place we have been given in the larger scheme of God's plans, the Psalmist exclaims: "what are human beings that you are mindful of them, mortals that you care for them? Yet you



have made them a little lower than the angels, and crowned them with glory and honour. You have given them dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under their feet," (Psalm 8: 4-6). As we reflect on the gospel of this weekend, we are reminded among other things that we are trusted to look after the works of God's hands. The earth is the LORD'S, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it, (Psalm 24:1 & 1 Cor 10:26). Although the earth is the Lord's, God has given the earth to humans to nurture and look after. The earth, which God created, beautified and gave to us, is like the vineyard in the gospel of this weekend.

The gospel opens with Christ saying to the chief priests and elders of the people, 'there was a landowner who planted a vineyard, put a fence around it, dug a wine press in it, and built a watchtower. Then he leased it to tenants and went to another country,' (Matthew 21:33-34). The owner of the vineyard ensured that all the hard work in the vineyard was done before it was given away. Those who were entrusted with looking after the vineyard did not have to fence it, neither did they have to dig a wine press or even build a watchtower. Everything needed to get the vineyard ready was completed before it was leased out. Once leased, the owner did not stay around to supervise those who had been charged with the responsibility of looking after it - he went abroad.

As human beings, one of the most important gifts God has given us is the gift of life. Every human life is fundamentally a gift from God. In the beginning, "the LORD God formed man from the dust of the ground. He breathed the breath of life into the man's nostrils, and the man became a living person. Then the LORD God planted a garden in Eden in the east, and there He placed the man he had made", (Genesis 2:7-8). God has entrusted us with this massive vineyard called life. The founder, CEO and pastor of the Christian Cultural Centre Megachurch in Brooklyn, New York, Alfonso R. Bernard, aptly captured the sense of life as gift when he said: "life is God's gift to us. What we do with it is our gift to God."

What we do with the life God has given us matters. God wants us to cultivate and nurture 'grapes, sweet smelling grapes, bundles of grapes' - bundles of love - in the vineyard of our lives. In the second reading, as he writes to the Philippians, Saint Paul, in a sense, underlines the fact that human life is like a vineyard which has been given to us. In that vineyard, Saint Paul believes that human life needs to be nurtured and cultivated producing

SATURDAY 4th November (new date)



All Souls Day

Thursday 2nd November

This year's commemoration of All Souls falls on Thursday 2nd November. There will be the usual 9am morning Mass at Saint Paschal's and another Mass at Saint Gerard's at 7pm in the evening. At the evening Mass at Saint Gerard's, Parishioners will be invited to bring spare copies of funeral booklet, framed, or unframed pictures of deceased family members, relatives, and friends. These items will be displayed on a decorated table and parishioners are encouraged to light a candle as they drop these photos/items on the table.

As from this weekend, the November Mass envelopes will be available for parishioners who would like their deceased family members, relatives, and friends to be remembered in all the Masses throughout the month of November. These names would be typed out, put into PowerPoint, and be displayed before each weekend Mass in November. Since the names of the dead will not be limited to those who have died this year, the office will need time to type and get these names ready before All Souls Day Mass. Parishioners can write on the envelope or write on a separate paper and insert it into the envelop. There is no fee but a donation. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, our prayers for the dead "are capable not only of helping them, but also of making their intercessions for us effective." Furthermore, "it is a holy and a wholesome thought to pray for the dead that they may be loosed from their sins," (2 Maccabees 12:46). May eternal rest grant and perpetual rest be granted to the dead as we pray for them.


