# SUNDAY 19th November 2023 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

Chermside West Wavell Heights

In the gospel this weekend, Jesus told the parable of a master, who, before going abroad, summoned his servants and gave each of them talents according to their individual abilities. In this parable, the word 'talent' means money and not skills. When the master called his three servants and gave each of them money, the first two servants took the accounts they got and invested



them, and the value was doubled when the master returned. However, the third servant was rather odd, he chose to bury the money his master had given him and simply did nothing with it. God never demands from us things we are incapable of doing but only things we can do. The three servants were given gifts according their individual capabilities. One was given five dollars, another two and another one. They were simply given an amount of money according to their abilities. While the servants who received five and two respectively used their talents diligently and doubled the amount received, the third servant just buried his own in the ground.

Pope St. Pius X composed this prayer to Saint Joseph which is worth praying and reflecting upon. The prayer says: "Glorious St. Joseph, model of all those who are devoted to labour, obtain for me the grace to work conscientiously, putting the call of duty above my many sins; to work with thankfulness and joy, considering it an honour to employ and develop, by means of labour, the gifts received from God; to work with order, peace, prudence and patience, never surrendering to weariness or difficulties; to work, above all, with purity of intention, and with detachment from self, having always death before my eyes and the account which I must render of time lost, of talents wasted, of good omitted, of vain complacency in success so fatal to the work of God." It's important that, as we continue on our pilgrimage through this transient life, we keep always before our eyes that at the end of this life, we will be asked about how well we utilised the time we had in life, what we did with the gifts God gave us and how much good we did, by touching the lives of others and making a difference in their lives.

The Christian faith flourishes and diminishes on the truth of this parable. As Christians when we were baptised, we were all given a priceless gift of faith - a gift we ought to put into daily use and not hide away in a cupboard. Faith is not only a foundational gift, but also one that opens the door to others such as: Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge, Counsel, Fortitude, Piety and Awe of the Lord. These are the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. We received these gifts when we were confirmed. Like every good gift, we need to ensure that they are integral parts of our daily life. There is a correlation between the first reading and the gospel. The worthy or perfect wife in the first reading is someone who received many talents and put all of them to good use.

In appreciation of these readings, I hope we can take stock of the many gifts God has given us, and still gives us in this life. When we use our gifts from God, we are not only making ourselves good and faithful servants, but also missionary disciples of Christ in our world. When we do good to others, people who benefit from our Godgiven gifts can see Jesus Christ in and through us. There are many wonderful people whose gifts have brought significant blessings to our parish community and beyond. Our Lady of the Angels is very blessed with many generous and kind-hearted people who are just happy to share their God-given gifts and talents.
