SUNDAY 3rd December 2023 First Sunday of Advent - Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

This weekend we begin the season of Advent. Etymologically, the word 'Advent' comes from the Latin word 'advenio,' "to come to," and refers to the coming of Christ. In the Christian calendar, 'The season of Advent' is a period of preparation extending over the four Sundays before Christmas. Typically, while Advent is regarded as a joyous season, it is also intended to be a season of waiting and expectation, much like the season of Lent. Expectation and waiting inextricably form part of our lives as humans, though we are not always good at waiting and living in expectation. Often times we like to be on the move, with hardly any time to stop and reflect. The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, as bad as it was, forced humanity to stop for once. Whether it was planned or unplanned, gradual or sudden, we experienced during the pandemic an unprecedented shift in the way we lived and did things. Before the outbreak of the pandemic, who would have thought that a whole state could go into total or partial lockdown? 'There is good in every evil' is an old saying which held true in our experience of COVID-19. Regrettably many people died from the virus and many got sick, but the outbreak of Covid-19 ushered in an unexpected Advent in human history. The hustle and bustle which are often characteristic of human life gave way to a slow pace sort of lifestyle. We were forced to be home to ourselves and to realise like Mahatma Gandhi once said that, 'our greatness as humans lies not so much in being able to remake the world as being able to remake ourselves.'

The waiting and expectation which are characteristics of the season are intended to help us to rediscover and remake ourselves. In the readings this weekend, especially the gospel, we are admonished to "stay awake, be prepared," for the Son of Man is coming.' There is a greater urgency for us to live in the now. We are meant to live every day as if the second coming of Christ were years away but also live as if it will happen now. As we begin this season of Advent, let us find time to be quiet and be at home to ourselves. We can do this at the start of the day with a morning prayer or sometime during the day with a cup of coffee or tea. It will be helpful to have a sacred space with a candle, a crucifix or a sacred image and Bible. When you are in this sacred space, you can read a passage from the Bible or say a decade of the Rosary or simply spend time in gratitude to God who has blessed us and continues to bless us. While the season of Advent is a time of waiting and expectation, it also reminds us that Christ is always with us and amongst us. As Christians, we are not only aware of Christ's presence around us and among us but we also celebrate His presence in the person of the priest who leads the celebration of Mass, proclaims the Gospel, preaches and who during the Eucharistic Prayer offers praise and thanks to God and does what Jesus did at the Last Supper.

Additionally, we celebrate Christ's presence in the readings from Scripture proclaimed at Mass, as well as in each other-the gathered assembly. Finally, we celebrate and adore Christ's presence in the elements of bread and wine which become Christ's Body and Blood. Christ has never been away from us. Christ is amongst us and His presence lives on in the challenges associated with living the Christian message.

As we begin the season of Advent, let us ensure that 'the waiting and expectation' we celebrate liturgically this season will lead us to discover and contemplate the presence of Christ around us and among us every day.

Mass Changes

From this weekend, 3rd & 4th December, some changes will be introduced during the Mass.

- 1. The Readers and Ministers of Communion will gather at the door and enter the church in the entrance procession.
- 2. The first collection will be taken up after the homily (instead of before the first reading). The second collection will be in its usual position after the Prayers of the Faithful.
- 3. Music will cease when the distribution of communion has finished so that there is a period of silence for private reflection and prayer.
- 4. Distribution of the Holy Blood will re-commence for those who wish to receive it.
 - a) Note that the only accepted way for Catholics to receive the Holy Blood is by sharing the cup. Dipping the host in the wine (intinction) is not approved.
 - b) Please do not receive the Holy Blood if you are unwell.
 - c) To enable an efficient flow in the communion processsion, the people in the "slanted" seats at St Gerard's will be asked to wait until communion has been received by those nearest the Sacred Heart Statue and then move in the opposite direction from usual ie towards the atrium and back by the aisle between the two sections of seating. An usher will direct.

Thank you for your continued support. Your contributions will certainly make a big difference to our most vulnerable families this Christmas.




