# SUNDAY 24th December 2023 Fourth Sunday of Advent - Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,
Like most girls of her time, the Virgin Mary must have had
plans and dreams of who she wanted to marry, and spend
the rest of her life with, but the God of pleasant surprises
had a different plan for her. Mary's perspective on
marriage and family would have come from her mum and
dad, Joachim and Anne. She must have wanted the same



type of commitment that her parents shared. But all her plans and dreams changed because God had destined her to be an active player in the drama of the incarnation. Mary was just an ordinary young Galilean lady who found herself in the enviable position of being chosen by God to be the Mother of our Saviour Jesus Christ. When it became obvious to her that God's plan was different, Mary had no hesitation in agreeing. It was through faith, obedience, humility and of course with a sense of wonder and awe, that Mary cooperated with the divine plan as God moulded her into the new Eve.

In the gospel this weekend, as Luke presents this supplementary unit to the nativity stories of John the Baptist (Luke 1:5-25), and Jesus Christ (Luke 1:26-38), we read about Mary's initial silence and puzzlement. 'Mary was deeply disturbed by the angel's greeting and asked herself what this greeting could mean' (Luke 1:29). It took a bit of convincing from Angel Gabriel before Mary was ready to set out in haste to visit her cousin Elizabeth who was already in her sixth month of pregnancy. Mary was spontaneously surprised by the immensity and beauty of her encounter with Angel Gabriel. She was overwhelmed with joy. It was a contagious joy which Mary couldn't contain. She responded by setting out in haste to share the good news with her cousin Elizabeth.

Like Mary, who responded quickly to share the good news with her cousin Elizabeth, how do we intend to celebrate this year's Christmas as we come to the end of the Advent season? Do we intend to celebrate alone or with others? Mary took the initiative to reach out to her cousin so that Elizabeth could share in what God has done for her. As Christians, we cannot sit and feel untouched by the agony and loneliness of the homeless, the elderly, the sick and all those who for one reason or the other cannot celebrate this joyful season. While Christmas is a joyful season for many; it is sadly very different for others. These might be people who are going through separation and divorce, those who have been ostracised from their family, or who are nursing the painful emotion of losing a dear one. The list can go on, but let's spare some thoughts for these people and keep them in our prayers, reaching out where we can. Joy shared is joy lived to the fullest.

In 1999, Saint Pope John Paul II during one of his Angelus messages said: 'Christmas is not simply the remembrance of the event that took place over 2000 years ago when, according to the Gospel, the power of God took on the

### Blue Card News - November 2023

Clarifying the Difference between Exemption Cards and Exemptions.

Exemption cards are a type of blue card that are only issued to Queensland police officers and teachers registered with the Queensland College of Teachers.

While police and teachers <u>do not need</u> an **exemption card** to undertake their regular duties as they are already screened by other government bodies, they do need to apply for an exemption card to engage in regulated activities outside their professional duties. For example, a police officer assisting with the Parish Sacramental Program or a teacher <u>volunteering</u> with Children's Liturgy Ministry.

While police officers and teachers are already screened for their regular employment, holding an **exemption card** means that they are also subject to continuous monitoring for relevant changes through the blue card system. This means that should a police officer or teacher have a change in their criminal history or disciplinary information that results in a change to their exemption card status, notification of this change is sent to their other linked organisations.

Child-related activities or services are regulated by the <u>Working with</u> <u>Children (Risk Management and Screening) Act 2000</u> (the Act), they need to hold a blue card, unless an exemption applies. Under the Act Exemption Cards and Exemptions are separate concepts.

#### **Exemptions under the Act**

Under the Act, there are specific exemptions from screening that can apply to certain individuals, meaning that they do not need to apply for, or hold, a Blue Card for activities or services that are otherwise regulated by the Act.

Some exemptions from screening include:

Volunteers under the age of 18,

Volunteer parents whose children are participating in the ativties they provide themselves to other children, e.g., a parent who volunteers for a reading or art program at their child's school.

The Act allows other exemptions from Blue Card screening for:

Ambulance Officers,

Lawyers providing legal or advocacy services,

Registered health practitioners,

Employees under the Corrective Services Act 2006,

People providing help or guidance to a child employee, i.e., work experience.

Understanding the difference is important to ensure compliance with the Blue Card System.


