

SUNDAY 31st March 2024 EASTER SUNDAY— Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors, It's indisputable that the world is full of good people and beautiful things are happening every day in Australia and around the world. However, it's also true that we live today in a world and in a country where many are hurting, sick, wounded and suffering. The ongoing ravaging effects of war in some parts of the world, the intense economic and health crises, high rates of mortality, depression, loss of job, family breakdown, and so many other challenges humanity is



facing today have their adverse effects and impacts on human lives, not only in Australia but around the world. The good news is that it's in the midst of everything we are experiencing in our world that we celebrate the great Feast of Easter. It couldn't have come at a better time than now. Alleluia, Jesus Christ is Risen from the dead to die no more! What joy we have as we celebrate Christ's resurrection from the dead which is a celebration of victory over everything that weighs us down and impedes our capacity to live life to the fullest.

There are at least four major religions in the world: Buddhism, Islam, Judaism and Christianity. Each of these rests on a historical figure: Buddha, Mohammad, Abraham and Jesus Christ. Amongst all these personalities, only Jesus Christ died and rose from the dead. Over the tomb of Buddha, Mohammad, Abraham, is written, "occupied" but the tomb of Christ is empty because Christ died and rose from the dead to die no more. Death couldn't hold Him captive. Jesus Christ remains the greatest person in history. He had no servants; but many called Him Master. He had no army; but the world super military powers feared Him. He had no academic degrees; but He was the Rabbi par excellence. He did not go to any medical college; yet He was the greatest healer and physician. He won no military battle; yet He conquered the world with love and His message of good news. He won no crown; yet people called Him King of kings and Lord of lords. He committed no crime; but the chief priests, the Scribes and the elders of the people crucified Him. Even though He was crucified and buried, He was resurrected and still lives today. Christ is not just alive, but Christ is a living and active presence amongst us.

The readings especially the gospels for both the Easter Vigil and the Mass of the Easter day do not specifically relate what happened to Jesus Christ at the moment of His resurrection. However, what the readings have done quite well is the narration of the implications of the resurrection of Christ in the lives of believers. With the resurrection, every believer is now on the threshold of a new life. A wonderful world has opened up before us, inviting us to step into it with hope and optimism. Christ's resurrection is a declaration of the light of Christ, which shines brightly into the dark places of our lives. Whether it is in the form of sickness, financial hardship, family crisis, depression or death-Christ's light shines and gives us hope.

The resurrection of Christ fundamentally means that we can have a lasting relationship with God - the God of the living and the dead. It also means that in our struggles and difficulties, we are victorious and triumphant through the Blood of the Lamb (Revelation 12:11). We can never be alone in our struggles. When life seems chaotic and difficult, Christ's victory over death lights up our way and shines brighter

Christian Meditation Group


There will be No Meditation Group on **Monday 1st of April**. The Meditation Group will resume as usual on **Monday 8th of April**.
