SUNDAY 21st April 2024 Fourth Sunday of Easter — Year B

Dear Parishioners, Friends and Visitors,

Traditionally, the fourth Sunday of Easter is called 'Good Shepherd Sunday or Vocation Sunday.' Across the three years of the Church's liturgical calendar, the gospel of this weekend is taken from chapter 10 of the fourth gospel- the gospel of Saint John. This chapter from the Johannine gospel aptly forms part of the Easter readings because



it underlines the depth of Christ's sacrificial death on the cross for the salvation of the world. Jesus is the 'Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep'.

The Old Testament, especially the Psalms and Prophets are replete with many depictions of God as a 'Shepherd, who leads and nurtures His children like a flock. 'The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want' (Psalm 23:1). 'God leads His people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron' (Psalm 77:20). 'He is our God, and we are His people, the sheep of His pasture,' (Psalm 100:3). The nurturing and caring nature of God as a Shepherd evident in the psalms is also proclaimed by the prophets. Isaiah prophesized how 'God will feed His flock like a shepherd, gather the lambs with His arms, and carry them in His bosom,' (Isaiah 40:11). Historically, the leaders of the Israelites were described as the shepherds of God's people. The Old Testament prophets like Jeremiah and Ezekiel had tremendous indictments of the false leaders who sought their own good rather than the good of the flock entrusted to their charge. 'Cursed be the leaders that destroy and scatter the sheep of God's pasture,' (Jeremiah 23:1-4). 'Cursed be to the shepherds of Israel that feed themselves, when they should be feeding the flock,' (Ezekiel 34).

Jesus Christ draws upon an Old Testament image as He describes Himself as the 'Good Shepherd par excellence.' Christ does not make a false claim as He calls Himself the Good Shepherd. He is the dedicated and conscientious shepherd who leads His sheep; He is the 'Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep. On the cross of Calvary, Christ showed in a concrete manner what it means to die for the sheep. In order to distinguish Himself as the Good Shepherd par excellence, Christ says: "my sheep listen to my voice; I know them and they follow me," (John 10:27).

Today, we live in an era when there are so many discordant voices that call for attention. As we contemplate Jesus the Good Shepherd, we need to pray that we may always listen to Christ's voice. As Christians, we should not be afraid to follow Christ, the Good Shepherd. In the midst of many confusing voices, let us remain attuned to the voice of Jesus Christ. In this age of smart phones and tablets, we need to download Jesus Christ into our life and homes as we download apps into our phones and tablets.

Our world is witnessing what could be described as the enormously injurious consequences of living daily without inner peace and harmony. Almost every day, we hear about war and violence and their devastating impacts. In one of his messages, Pope Francis said: "it is important for Christians in their daily journey of life to recognise that God's presence is stronger than evil, especially today in a world marked by violence, divisions and indifference, where the selfishness of selfaffirmation without regard for others obscures the simple beauty of welcoming, sharing and loving."

In the coming days of the week and every day of our life in this transient world, let us

FIRE PREVENTION Candle Safety in Church

Each year, Church properties experience serious fires resulting from the misuse of candles. The damage caused from these fires ranges anywhere from a few thousand dollars to total destruction costing millions of dollars. Since candles are an important symbol of the Church and are readily used in Church properties, the following guidelines must be followed to reduce the chance of fire in our churches.

- 1. Do not buy candles and bring them into the church to use. Only use parish bought candles. Many of the candles purchased at discount stores are improperly made and have been the source of numerous fires.
- 2. Do not light an oil-based, long-burning candle and leave in the church until it runs out of fuel and snuffs itself out. Such a candle has been left burning overnight in the church and poses a serious risk of a source of fire.
- 3. Never leave a candle burning in an unoccupied room. The only exceptions would be for votive candles or the sanctuary lamp candle. These candles are specifically manufactured to burn until they self-extinguish.
- 4. Never let candles burn for more than four hours at a time. The same exceptions as above would apply.
- 5. Parents are to keep an eye on their children to ensure that they do not play with lighters, lighting tapers, and matches.
- 6. Extinguish candles with snuffers to avoid burns or scorching by tiny candlewick sparks. The altar cloth at St Gerard's has tiny scorch marks.
- 7. The flame of a candle should not be closer than 7 cm or 3 inches to other candle flames.
- 8. No lit candles on live or artificial holiday greenery. Exception: Any artificial wreath (i.e. advent wreath must be fire retardant treated and candles set in protective container).

Please check the Parish website for documentation required when making a booking.




